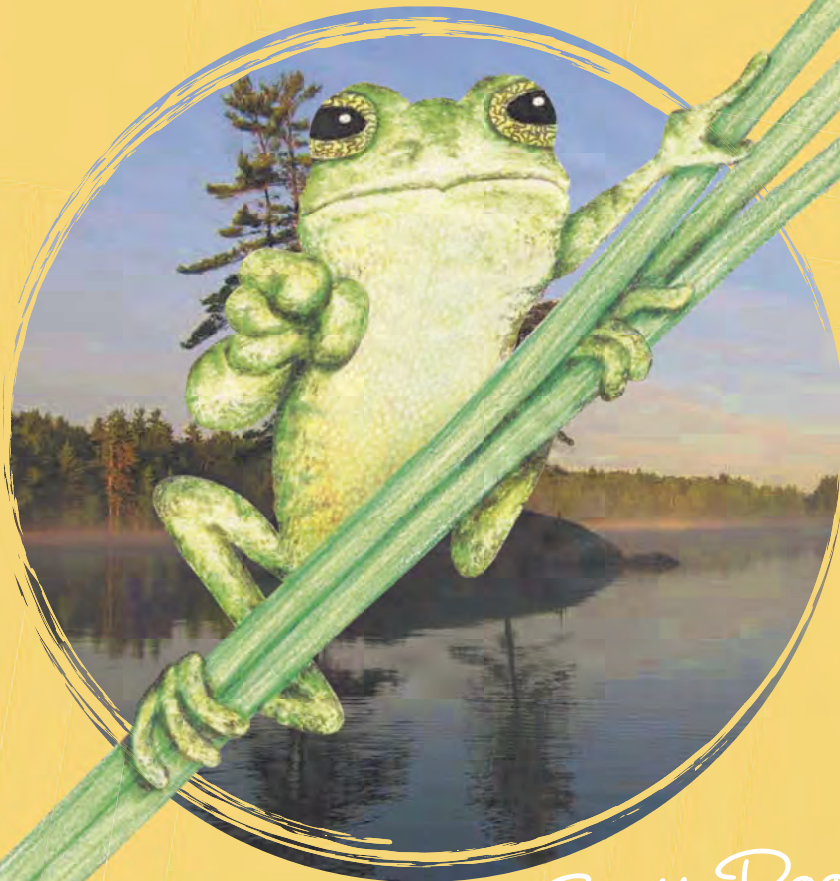

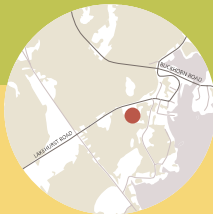

LAND KNOWLEDGE CIRCLES WILL BE HELD ACROSS THE REGION ON SATURDAYS FROM 10AM TO 4PM



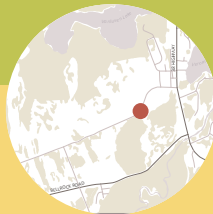

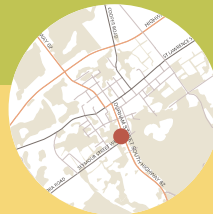
