In March, Seguin Township Council rejected a proposed recommendation to introduce a short-term rental (STR) by-law and licensing program. Meanwhile, the City of Kawartha Lakes Council voted on April 18th to move ahead with their STR bylaw, implementing a soft start to the program for 2023 that includes a yearly license.
