By-law Services – Wednesday July 7th reference notes

- O What is the role of a By-law officer?
 - My role here is assist all those who have questions, but most importantly, to apply our by-laws to an alleged violation which does two things – protects a person's safety and enjoyment of their property and supports the successful continuation of the Township
- What is and is not covered by the By-law officer in Lake of Bays?
 - NOT COVERED by By-law:
 - ✓ Trespassing by person or vehicle
 - ✓ Off-road vehicles along roadways
 - ✓ Boats & 'on-water" activities
 - ✓ Hunting, Quarries, Disposal of dead animals
 - By-law does cover the following: (and more)
 - √ Dog tags, vendor licences, commercial agreements
 - √ Improper use of Township property roads, parks, etc.
 - ✓ Property Standards, Use of Firearms (non-hunting)
 - ✓ Land and shoreline activities building, littering, vegetation
 - ✓ Dog concerns, Improper open-air burning, Smoking in a park
 - ✓ Illegal dumping in garbage receptacles
 - ✓ Complete list found on our website
- Lake association versus Township staff what is my role? I can be a good resource for the public and any members of LOBA.
- O How are by-laws enforced?
 - Voluntary Compliance
 - √ behaviour stopped, no further negative impacts
 - Warning
 - √ No re-occurring offence is expected, first offence
 - Tickets
 - √ Financial deterrent, does not stop the offence
 - √ There are now two types of "tickets" you may hear about:
 - POA these are approved by the Office of the Attorney General and are referred to as POA (Provincial Offences Act) penalty notice.

- AMPS these can be approved by the Township and are referred to as an "AMP" (Administrative Monetary Penalty).
- ✓ AMPS are being approved this fall. These fines can be issued to the offender OR to the owner of the property where the offence occurred
- ✓ POA Part I tickets are issued in person directly to offender
- Notice / Order
 - √ Timeline can be immediate to longer term
 - √ Issued when remedy is required, or offence needs to cease
 - √ Re-planting, illegal items removed, damage repaired
- Set fines
 - ✓ Can be issued as a ticket or because of a court conviction
 - ✓ Limits are set by Provincial legislation or Municipal Act
- Charges
 - ✓ Serious or ongoing offences
 - ✓ Conviction required for the Township to request remedy or for fines to be applied
- Confidentiality FIPPA
 - When interacting with a person who is trying to figure who "ratted on them" – my grounds for being there is all I need to share
 - Request for Service must have your contact info, BUT this is kept confidential and assured, unless in-court testimony is required
- o How can people help me assist with their concerns?
 - Provide clear evidence of alleged violation loose dog? Fire?
 - Provide clear location or description of alleged offender
 - PLEASE do not wait to contact me because you are trying to be patient – on-going actions need to be addressed sooner than later
- Evidence
 - PLEASE gather from a public place, do not trespass
 - PHOTO or VIDEO up to 32mB in size
 - Noise log or notes date, time, and description

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Short-term Rentals

- Full licencing program is expected to start January 2022
- Registered STR:
 - ✓ be inspected by the Township, others
 - √ provide information on their rental
 - √ owners and renters adhere to code of conduct for use
- Will take violations of a property or renters and apply them against the registered STR licence / Tax roll

Vegetation Cutting

- Along the shoreline
- On a property that is NOT waterfront
- INTENT TO CUT township form completed for free, with photo
- Clearing for a house prior to a posted building permit

Development Permit By-law

- Regulates MANY aspects of how properties can be used or modified
- Prior to ANY work that is done within 20 m / 65.6 ft of shore some lakes have a 30m setback or if you have a type one fish habitat (WEP area in front of the lot setback is also 30 m)
- Shoreline buffers along property lines, defined activity areas 15m from shore inland, etc

Noise

- Fireworks are now allowed on July 1st ONLY, and all other statutory holiday weekends
- Overly loud gatherings
- Making noise outside the permitted time frames

Dark Skies

- We seek to prevent the following:
 - ✓ Glare light that reduces others ability to see
 - ✓ Light Pollution light that points upwards
 - ✓ Light Trespass light that leaves the property

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- Examples of prohibited lights:
 - ✓ Outward facing light on bubblers or on a dock
 - ✓ Flashing warning lights along the lake
 - ✓ Spot lights that cause unsafe glare
- Applies to OUTSIDE lights installed after 2013
- Bulb should NOT be visible from the side
- Great examples on the last page of our Dark Sky By-law
