## Land Acknowledgement

In the spirit of reconciliation, many communities and organizations use land acknowledgements to recognize the enduring relationship that exists between Indigenous Peoples and their traditional territories, and to recognize Indigenous Nations as sovereign.

I deliver this land acknowledgement as an expression of gratitude and appreciation to those on whose territory we gather, and as a way of honouring the Indigenous Peoples who have been living and working on this land for centuries and continue to do so to this day. Their connection to this land transcends colonial systems, beliefs, surrenders and treaties, and the Lake of Bays region continues to be home to many First Nations, Metis and Inuit people today. These lands are covered by the Williams Treaty of 1923 and the Robinson-Huron Treaty of 1850. We must seek to understand and respect these treaties and ensure our governments do too.

In Muskoka, we are on the traditional territory of the Anishnaabeg, which includes the Ojibwe, Odawa, Algonquin and Potawatomi Nations. The Huron-Wendat, the Haudenosaunee Nations and others have also walked on this territory over time. Their legacy and respectful stewardship for this land continues to shape the Lake of Bays region today.

We must remember that, as settlers, we continue to benefit from the colonization and forced sacrifices of Indigenous Peoples. We must examine our collective decision making to ensure Indigenous sovereignty so we can all move forward in a healthy way.

We all join this virtual meeting from different locations and I challenge everyone here to seek out knowledge - share what you know, look inward and outward - and take actions toward real truth and reconciliation in support of our commitment to wellness for all, and to walking the path together in respect, peace and harmony for future generations.







- US and international members unable to access their seasonal properties






